Re: RTC Transportation Service

Dear Parent/Guardian,

We are excited to announce the partnership between the Clark County School District Transportation Department and the Regional Transportation Commission (RTC) will continue for the 2022-2023 school year. This program aims to provide students at select high schools a more independent, reliable, and flexible service to and from school.

Effective **Monday, August 8, 2022**, designated high school students will begin to utilize the RTC transit system in lieu of CCSD transportation services. Parents and students are welcome to join a virtual informational meeting at the below scheduled days and times:

Tuesday, August 2, 2022, at 11:30 AM
Wednesday, August 3, 2022, at 6:00 PM
Thursday, August 4, 2022, at 8:00 AM

In order to utilize the RTC on the first day of school, students will need to:

1. Complete the [Registration Form](https://forms.gle/tEC3uj2MNFSCsu9U8) (<https://forms.gle/tEC3uj2MNFSCsu9U8>) or visit <https://transportation.ccsd.net/ride-on/> and complete the form. When completing the form, **please use the student's CCSD issued Gmail address**. Notification of eligibility will be sent directly to the student's Gmail account.
2. Download the free **rideRTC** app on their mobile device from the Apple App store, Google Play store, or <https://www.rtcnv.com/ridertc/>
3. Log in or create an account. Students will need to have an account on the rideRTC. **Students must use the student's CCSD issued Gmail address**. If creating a new account, you will be sent an email to verify your account. Please make sure to verify. This is an important step.
4. Once steps 1-3 are complete, the student will be issued an electronic 30-day bus pass. Each month, RTC will issue a new 30-day pass until the end of the school year.
5. Using the rideRTC app, select "My Passes" to register your electronic pass
6. Activate your pass before boarding the bus. All passes are delivered to your mobile wallet on your smartphone within the app. Use it to ride any route.

For students who do not have access to a mobile phone, a paper pass will be provided upon request and will be issued at the school.
